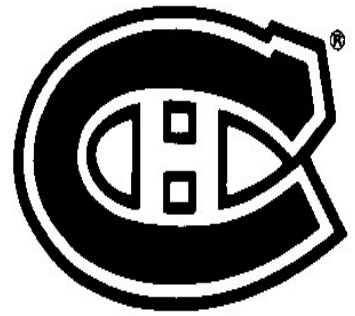

SPECIAL NOTICE:

Proof of citizenship required on trips to Canada. All members must have in their possession proof of citizenship for immigration identification when entering Canada and upon returning to the United States. During a transition period between Jan. 31, 2008 and the full imposition of new rules most likely during the summer of 2008, travelers at the Canadian border will need to present government-issued photo ID and proof of citizenship, like a birth certificate or passport. **Your Driver's License may not be acceptable by itself.**

SPECIAL NOTICE – CONTINUED

NEW REGULATION ON ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION AT BORDER CROSSINGS.

In light of the current increased security at international border crossings, each member is reminded to have proper documentation on their person entering Canada and returning back into the United States. During a transition period between Jan. 31, 2008 and the full imposition of new rules most likely during the summer of 2008, land travelers at the Canadian border will need to present government-issued photo ID and proof of citizenship, like a birth certificate or passport. Additionally, proof that you actually live in the U.S. (such as a photo driver’s license, voter’s registration card, etc.) may also be requested. Naturalized U.S. citizens should carry a naturalization certificate or some other evidence of citizenship. We believe on or about Summer, 2008, passports will be required of all US Citizens at land border crossings into and returning from Canada. We can expect delays in entry or re-entry border locations.

You will be required to show your ID to the bus leader prior to departure

Persons under 18 years of age who are not accompanied by an adult family member (over 18) should have in their possession a letter from their parent or guardian giving them permission to travel to Canada under the supervision and the name of the person who has control and authority of them.

Non-compliance can result in the passenger being refused entry into Canada or back into the United States, which will cause trip interruption not only for the person involved but for everyone on that bus. Any member who is denied entry or re-entry will be left at the border and it is his/her responsibility to get home at his/her own expense.

RETURNING WITH GIFTS / PURCHASES:

Members going on the trip are requested to get a U.S. Customs Information Guide. The DFC is in contact with the Visitors Centre in Canada requesting information on their visitor rebate program. More information will be in your confirmation letter.
